- Apply for advance standing into the Bachelor of Arts (Multimedia), RMIT



Work Experience

Students who apply for the Xero Design Work Experience Program will be eligible to begin their placement approximately six months from the start date of the Certificate III course. This ensures that students have base level skills before attempting work placement.

Students who join the Xero Design program will be eligible for 600 - 900 hrs work experience. Only full-time enrolled IDEA students are eligible for the Xero Design Work Experience Program which is additional to classroom hours.

Articulation details for higher ED offers

IDEA has had ongoing success in the past few years placing its Advanced Diploma graduates into third year degree programs at RMIT, Monash, Deakin and Swinburne Universities.

IDEA has also placed Advanced Diploma graduates in to Master's programs in Australia and overseas.

IDEA has the following formal agreement for articulation into Higher Education courses:

Central Queensland University (Melbourne) Master of Arts Administration



Upon completion of the Advanced Diploma of Multimedia or Graphic Arts programs with a pass grade or higher.

Swinburne University Bachelor of Design (Multimedia Design)



Minimum Entry Requirements for IDEA graduates

Advanced Diploma of Multimedia graduates who achieve an academic standard of an average score of 65%, and English language proficiency of either IELTS score of 6.0 are given exemptions of 200 credit points.

Diploma of Multimedia graduates entry into 2nd Year of Swinburne University's Bachelor of Design (Multimedia Design), giving exemptions of 100 credit points.

Deakin University Bachelor of Computing (Multimedia Technology)



Students from the Diploma of Multimedia will receive one-year credit towards the Degree and from the Advanced Diploma of Multimedia one and a half years credit.
