

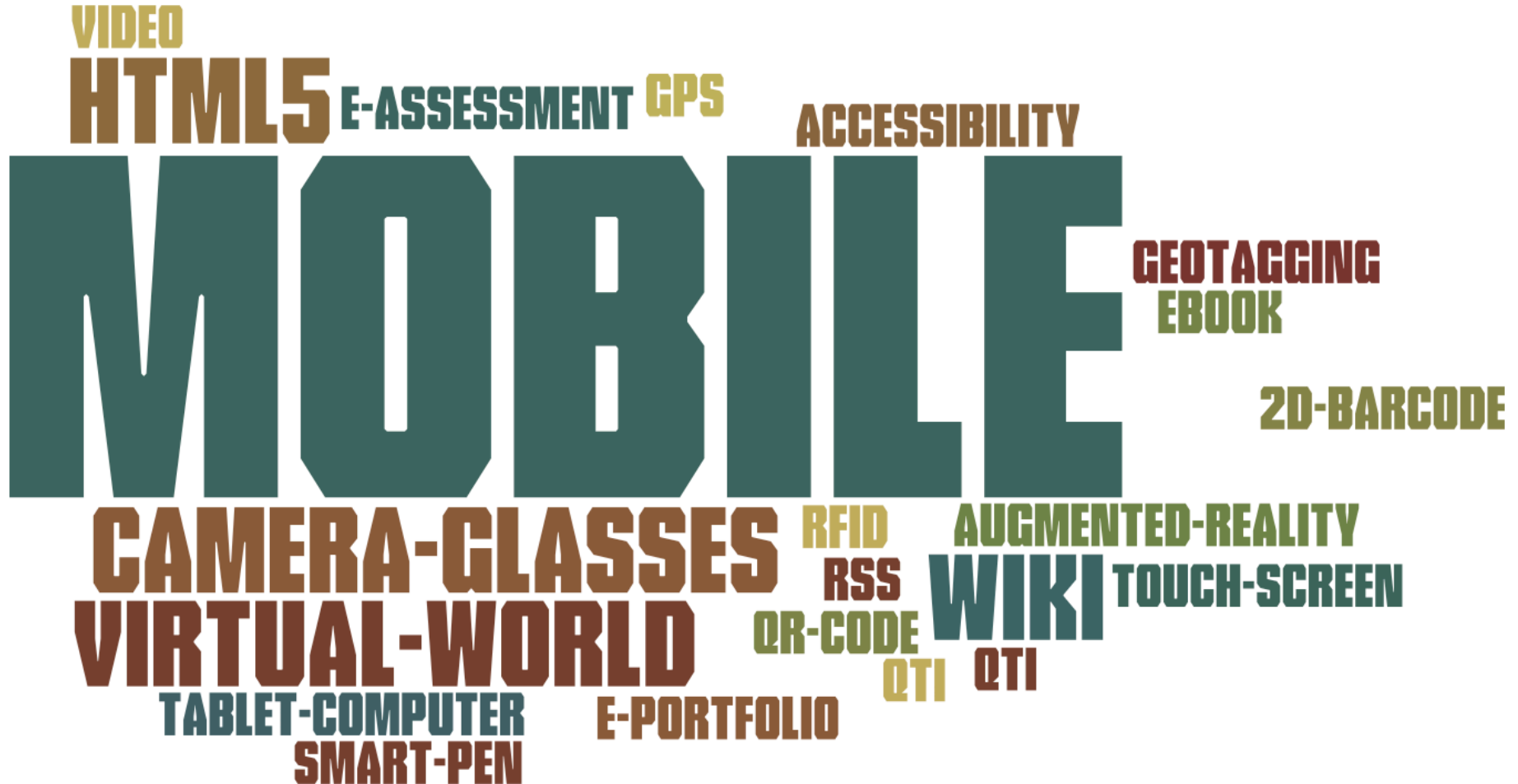

- Changing assessment culture

- Organisational change/procedural change

Technical issues often concern “appropriate” levels of security, access, identification, validation (how to define “appropriate”)
